reporting rule, allowed CPS Energy to leverage its existing Environmental Management Information System (EMIS) that would utilize the company's existing data already being captured for other air emission reporting and eliminate the need to enter data twice.

Implementing the Enviance System has enabled CPS Energy to create a single database repository that captures all emissions data. As a result, data resides in one place and can be used for multiple state and federal compliance reports (data “repurposing”), as well as other internal reporting requirements.

The System also serves as a single source for data entry, performs all the calculations, and generates an xml file based on the data results that is ready to submit into e-GGRT (the EPA's electronic Greenhouse Gas Reporting Tool) with a few mouse clicks – which results in considerable time saved.
