National Cooperative Refinery Association (NCRA) is an inter-regional cooperative engaged in crude oil acquisition, transportation, refining and product distribution. Products from NCRA's 85,000 barrel-per-day refinery are purchased by the Members-Owner cooperatives and distributed to their affiliated local farm supply cooperatives throughout the north-central United States. NCRA had been using the Enviance System for its Air Emissions Inventory reporting.
